
Alberta Land Sale Summary

LAND SALE HIGHLIGHTS: JUNE 1, 2022

Land Sale Results



The province sold 16,711 hectares of P&NG leases and licences in the June 1 land sale and earned \$13.64 million. There were also 256 hectares (1 section) of oilsands leases sold in the Clay area for \$30,697. This brings the total cumulative bonus paid to-date in 2022 to \$213.22 million. Highlights of this sale included:

- A) Valhalla: High price for this sale was \$5,125/ha for P&NG rights below base of the Doe Creek to base of the Charlie Lake, purchased by Petroland Services. Charlie Lake drilling has been active in this area (see Q4 2021 geoXPLORER report).
- B) Leduc-Woodbend: 2,928 hectares sold for \$3.76 million to RockEast Energy Corp. for rights mostly from surface to base Leduc. Aspenleaf has been actively drilling the Nisku in the area.
- C) Wildmere: 1,664 hectares of P&NG rights from surface and below base Viking to base Leduc were purchased for \$3.36 million by Millennium Land. Nearby production is from the Lloydminister sandstone.
